The cohort will meet face-to-face only one night per week throughout the program.

Admissions Requirements:
Completed bachelor's degree in any field with a minimum GPA of 2.6 (or 2.4 if a degree was earned greater than five years ago); currently a full-time working professional with four or more years work experience; must have completed basic prerequisite undergraduate level courses in statistics, financial accounting, microeconomics, and finance (or pass online proficiency modules offered by IUP) before starting the MBA course work in January 2014.
