CALENDAR OF IMPORTANT DATES – SPRING TERM 2018 (2184)

January 2	All University offices and buildings reopen
January 7	Residence halls open
January 8	Spring Term classes begin
January 15	Dr. Martin Luther King's birthday observance (University closed)
January 19	Spring Term add/drop period ends; students are encouraged to speak with their instructor if adding a class after January 12th
January 19	Last day to submit Buckley Amendment Refusal to Permit the Release of "Directory Information" forms to the Registrar
January 20	Spring Term extended drop period begins; a proposed drop must be approved by the student's academic advisor and cannot reduce the student's credit load below 12 credits.
January 26	Spring Term extended drop period ends
January 27	Monitored Withdrawal period begins; instructor must approve a class withdrawal beginning on this date
January 31	Last day to apply for April 2017 graduation; a \$15 late fee will be assessed for applications received after this date
February 2.....	Last day to exercise credit/audit grade option (contact the Office of the Registrar)
February 6.....	Advising appointment sign-ups for summer and fall 2017 registration will take place February 5-9
February 9.....	Summer Term veteran student enrollment appointments begin
February 12.....	Summer Term registration begins for all students
February 18.....	Mandatory advising appointments will begin in order for students to be able to self-enroll for fall classes
February 28	Spring Term midterm grades are due
March 4-11.....	Spring Recess for students (no classes); all University buildings and offices will remain open and staffed except on Spring Holiday
March 3.....	Residence halls close at 12:00 noon for Spring Recess
March 9.....	University's observance of Spring Holiday (University closed)
March 11.....	Residence halls reopen at 12:00 noon
March 14.....	Last day to withdraw from a course; a "W" grade will be assigned on the transcript
March TBA.....	Last day to resign from the Spring Term with a 60% tuition charge; thereafter, tuition charge is 100%
March 15.....	The Director of Academic Advising will approve course withdrawals beginning this date through the end of the term <u>only</u> in exceptional circumstances
March 23.....	Fall Term veteran student enrollment appointments begin
March 26.....	Fall Term registration appointments begin
April 20.....	Last session for all day classes (Monday-Friday) except for makeups
April 21.....	Reading period for all day classes
April 21-28.....	Evening and Saturday classes will continue to meet during this period and final exams will be held during the last scheduled class meeting
April 23-28.....	Final exam period for all classes
April 28	Spring Term ends; Commencement; Official date for degrees awarded in spring term
April 28	Residence halls close
May 2	Final grades must be marked "approved" by instructors by 12 noon before final grade posting can begin

*Failure to attend a class does not constitute an official resignation. Students are not automatically dropped when they do not attend classes. Students can drop classes during the Add/Drop and Extended Drop periods designated above. Students can withdraw a course (with instructor's signature) until March 14. Resignation from all classes (form available in the Office of the Registrar) is available until March TBA. Failure to drop or resign means that the student will be financially responsible for all courses. Students who do not drop, withdraw, or resign by the deadlines listed above may receive "F" grades in their courses.

The Pitt Greensburg Registrar reserves the right to make changes as are deemed necessary with the exception of those dates that appear in the University of Pittsburgh Academic Calendar.

Important Note about Billing: When applicable, bills are issued to students via Pitt email on the 22nd of each month and due on the 17th of the following month. If the bill is not paid by the 20th, a late fee is assessed.
