

Applied Research Minor

Students interested in Applied Research may choose to pursue a minor either to supplement the work in their majors or to fulfill the requirements for a related area within their majors. The minor in Applied Research requires that students complete five courses for a total or 16 or 17 credits (courses listed are three credits unless otherwise noted).

REQUIREMENTS:

Applied Research minors need to complete the following core courses:

COMMRC 1030 <i>OR</i>	Research Methods in Communication Studies
HIST 1010	Historical Inquiry and Methods
SOCSCI 1901	Applied Research Internship

At least one additional area of application or skills course should be completed from the following list. Note: INFSCI courses may have prerequisites that are not part of the minor.
