

Progression in Course Sequences

University of Pittsburgh at Greensburg (fall 2020)

The University of Pittsburgh at Greensburg requires that prerequisite courses must be successfully completed with a grade of C- or higher before a student can progress to the next level. For example, a student who earned a D in Foundations of Biology 1 cannot enroll in Foundations of Biology 2 until s/he earns at least a C- in Foundations of Biology 1, the prerequisite course.
