

Staff Council Meeting Minutes Wednesday, November 15, 2023

- I. Angie called the meeting to order.
- II. Angie confirmed that the minutes from 4/4/2023, that were distributed prior to the meeting, were received. There were no questions or edits. Jim moved to accept the minutes; Jackie seconded the motion.
- III. Jackie read the Treasurer's Report.
 - At the beginning of the calendar year, there was \$400.73 in the account. Event expenditures from this past year included: \$132/Souper Bowl; \$110.50/March Madness; \$100.49/Halloween Party. Revenue totalled \$63: \$43 from 50/50s and a \$20 donation. The ending fund balance is \$120.74.
 - 2. Discussion ensued on how to raise more funds.
 - a. Ideas included Sarris (30% profit, but others on campus are selling), Chick-fil-A, Texas Roadhouse
 - b. Dan said during his tenure, President Gregerson was willing to cover some expenses. The recycling of toner cartridges were directed to Staff Council. The program is no longer in effect.
 - c. Val reminded the group that revenue used to come from the Blue & Gold Celebration car cruise.
 - d. Sheila commented that potluck at events keeps expenses down and that Pitt Day of Giving (PDoG) takes place in February. This past year, there was challenge money available to the Staff Council account if the staff giving threshold was met—it wasn't.
