What's Next?



Accept your offer of admission.

To save your spot as a new Pitt student, follow the instructions at greensburg.pitt.edu/admissions/commit-to-pitt.



Activate your Pitt account.

Within 2 business days of accepting your admission offer, you should receive an email to activate your Pitt student account. Act on this immediately, and monitor your Pitt email regularly, as most information will be communicated through your Pitt email. Call [412-624-4357](tel:412-624-4357) with any questions about activating your Pitt student account.



Plan a visit with an admissions counselor.

Apply for financial aid.

Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov to be eligible for financial aid consideration. There is no charge for completing this form. The school code for Pitt is **008815**.



Apply for housing.

If you indicated that you need university housing when you accept your admissions offer, the housing office will contact you on how and when to start the application process.

- **Fall Term-** Expect to hear from the housing office via email by mid-April. The application goes live in mid-May.
- **Spring Term-** Expect to hear from the housing office via email 10-14 days after you accept your admissions offer.

The application is available online at the beginning of April. Housing is allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. If you have questions, please call the housing office at [724-836-7869](tel:724-836-7869) or email UPGHousing@pitt.edu.



Complete orientation.

You must complete an online orientation. After you accept your admissions offer, a link will be sent to your Pitt email. If you have questions regarding orientation, please call the student services office at [724-836-9954](tel:724-836-9954).



Register for classes.

Submit a request for an official transcript for each college or university you previously attended. The school should email the transcripts to upgimnow@pitt.edu. Then contact the Academic Advising Center at [724-836-9940](tel:724-836-9940) to make an appointment to schedule your classes. An official credit evaluation will be completed once all official college transcripts have been received.
